Precautions for safe handling:	Provide adequate ventilation. Wear appropriate personal protective equipment. Observe good industrial hygiene practices. Contains amines. Do not add sodium nitrite or other nitrosating agents which may form cancer causing nitrosamines. Contains a component that when heated at or above 300F (150C) may generate Formaldehyde vapors.
